RULES:

1. All of the General Rules and Regulation listed earlier in this book are applicable, unless overridden below.
2. All entries must be made in advance. They must be in the hands of the Secretary of the Erin Agricultural Society by September 30, 2011. Mail entries to: Erin Agricultural Society, P.O. Box 906, Erin, Ontario, N0B 1T0 or send by fax to 519-833-0673
3. The Poultry Show will take place on the Monday (Thanksgiving Day) of the Fair.
 - a. Maximum of two birds per section per exhibitor.
 - b. All entries must be in place by 9:00 a.m.
 - c. Only pre-registered entries will be accepted.
 - d. Please put A for cock, B for hen, C for cockerel and D for pullet.
 - e. Judging will commence at 9:30 a.m. No exhibitors will be allowed in the aisles while judging is in progress.
 - f. No birds are to be removed until 4:30 p.m.
 - g. No food or water will be provided by the Erin Agricultural Society.
4. The Erin Agricultural Society will take all precautions to insure the safety and welfare of the birds, but will not be responsible for loss or damage whatsoever, all birds being at the sole risk of the exhibitor.
5. The Judge's decisions shall be final. The new revised standard of perfection shall be the guide therein and all birds shall be judged by comparison.
 - a. No prize shall be awarded unless an entry is deemed worthy of same by the Judge.
 - b. There will be prizes in each section for each of cock, hen, cockerel and pullet.
 - c. Prizes will be paid for single birds.
6. **PRIZE MONEY:** 1st \$5.00, 2nd \$4.00, 3rd \$3.00, for standards, bantams, ducks and geese. Also see specials starting on page 60.
7. All birds must be pullorum free. Any bird showing any sign of illness will be removed from the show area.
