PRIZE MONEY: 1st \$25.00, 2nd \$20.00, 3rd \$17.00, 4th \$12.00, 5th \$10.00. \$10.00 to all remaining entries. Fair Board reserves the right to pay only half the prize money if less than three exhibitors in a Section.

SECTIONS:

1. Ewe-Yearling (3rd pair of temporary incisors must be in place)
2. Ewe-First pair of temporary incisors must be in place.
3. Ram-Yearling (3rd pair of temporary incisors must be in place).
4. Ram - First pair of temporary incisors must be in place.
5. Get of Sire - Group of three animals, first pair of temporary incisors must be in place, from one sire. Both sexes may be represented.
6. Breeders Flock - (bred and owned by exhibitor). A group of four animals, both sexes to be represented. Each animal in the group must have exhibited in one of the previous sections, all animals must also be in one breed.
7. **BENHAM MEMORIAL TROPHY** - For Championship Pen. Any breed. In honour of the late J.P. Benham, a long time exhibitor at the Erin Fall Fair. Winners name will be engraved thereon and will remain

the property of the exhibitor for one year. To be returned prior to next Fair.

8. ANY LAMB - Shown at 11:30 am. Shown by boy or girl under 16 years of age. \$5.00 for each exhibit
