1. Special Junior Showmanship Classes – Age of child as of January 1, 2011.
 - a. Boy or girl 6 years and under
 - b. Boy or girl 7 through 9 years old, inclusive
 - c. Boy or girl 10 through 12 years of age, inclusive
 - d. Boy or girl 13 through 15 years of age, inclusive
 - e. Boy or girl 16 through 21 years of age, inclusive

2. Junior calf, born March 1, 2011 or later

5. Summer yearling born June 1, 2010 to August 31, 2010
6. Junior yearling born March 1, 2010 to May 31, 2010
7. Intermediate yearling born December 1, 2009 to February 28, 2010
8. Senior Yearling, uncalved, born September 1, 2009 to November 30, 2009
9. JUNIOR CHAMPION FEMALE – Trophy donated by **RBC Royal Bank, Business Banking Centre, Fergus.**
10. JUNIOR HERD: Group of 3 heifers, the 3 animals must be bred by the same breeder (same prefix) and the breeder must own at least 2 of the animals.
11. Milking senior yearling born September 1, 2009 - February 28, 2010
12. Junior 2-year-old female, born March 1, 2009– August 31, 2009.
13. Senior 2-year-old female, born September 1, 2008 to February 28, 2009
14. 3-year-old female, born September 1, 2007to August 31, 2008 in milk or dry. If dry must be within 8 weeks of calving.
15. 4-year-old female, born September 1, 2006 to August 31, 2007 in milk or dry. If dry must be within 8 weeks of calving.
16. 5-year-old female, born September 1, 2005 to August 31, 2006 in milk or dry. If dry must be within 8 weeks of calving.
17. Mature Cow born prior to September 1, 2005 in milk or dry. If dry must be within 8 weeks of calving.
18. BEST BRED & OWNED: top bred and owned cow chosen from each section 11 to 17. Halter sponsored by various.
19. GRAND CHAMPION FEMALE: chosen from first 2 placing in Sections 11 to 17. Rosette. Award donated by **AGRI-BRANDS PURINA**
20. RESERVE GRAND CHAMPION FEMALE: Rosette
21. BEST UDDER: Judge shall designate best two udders in Sections 11 – 17. These shall compete for first and second Best Udders in the show. Prize money paid to first and second place only. BEST UDDER- Perpetual trophy donated by the late **H. Nykamp.**
22. BREEDERS HERD: Group of 3 animals, the 3 animals in group must be bred by the same breeder (same prefix) and the breeder must own at least 2 of the animals. Each animal in group must have been exhibited in one of the sections for single animals.
BREEDER'S HERD – Trophy donated by the former: **WATERLOO, WELLINGTON, DUFFERIN JERSEY ASSOCIATION INC.**
23. PRODUCTION TROPHY: for highest combined BCA among 1st and 2nd place winners in the senior competition. Award donated in memory of **SHERWOOD TAYLOR.**
24. PREMIER BREEDER and PREMIER EXHIBITOR AWARDS: based on the top 7 entries donated by **SELECT SIRES.**
25. TWO SWEEPSTAKE CERTIFICATES: all exhibitors are entered in the draw. Award donated by **GENCOR.**
