RULES AND REGULATIONS:

1. All riders to be **18 years of age or under** as of Fair date.
2. All riders must wear approved hard hats with attached harness.
3. Ponies or horses are allowed. No stallions.
4. English or western tack is acceptable. Casual but suitable attire is required. Proper footwear to be worn at all times.
5. Entry Fee: Classes 1 - 15 -- \$3.00 per class
6. There will be a \$2.00 deposit for numbers to be refunded upon return of the numbers.

LUNCH BREAK: Will be held after Section 6, unless otherwise announced during the show.

1. Good Grooming – Entrants to lead their entries into the ring in full English or Western tack and attire. Entries will be judged on overall appearance and cleanliness of both horse/pony and person.

2. Leadline (7 years and under). Winner to receive free carnival ride tickets. All entrants will receive a prize.
3. Walk/Jog – 11 and under, entrant to ride.
4. Command Class. Entrants are excused from the ring for disobedience or performance faults.
5. Steady Hand – Riders will be given a glass full of water, they are asked to perform at all gaits, the person with the most water at the end wins.
6. Pole Bending (ages 12 and over). Entrants to complete a bending pattern -- time to count.

8. Costume Class – Creativity is judged (remember helmets still to be worn)

13. Telephone Book race. Each rider will be asked to find a page in a telephone book placed at their opposite end of the ring -- time to count.
14. Down and Back – Entrants will run down the arena and around a barrel and run back – time to count.
15. Flag Race – Each rider will run to a barrel with a flag in it, pick up the flag, race to the other end, around a barrel, and come back to drop the flag in the original barrel. Time to count.
