4. Pumpkins will be unloaded beginning at 8:30am
5. Minimum weight for entry is 80lbs
6. Only entries being 75% yellow/orange/cream in colour will be accepted
7. Those in a grey/green colour scheme will be disqualified as being squash
8. Any pumpkin with a hole, that is leaking or on the verge of collapse will be disqualified
9. Top five pumpkins will be on display at the fair throughout the weekend and will be available for pickup between 5pm and 7pm on Monday October 10, 2011
10. Judges are current Canadian record holders at 1678lbs – Jane and Phil Hunt from Cameron, Ontario
