Should there be more than six entries in any section, and on the advice of the judge, a fourth prize may be given. Entry tags must be securely fastened. Exhibitors are required to present their membership ticket and exhibitor's number, with a list of entries to the Director in charge before removing entries on Monday.

NOTE: Exhibitor may enter one item only per section.

SECTION: HOBBIES & CRAFTS

1. Thanksgiving wall hanging, kits accepted
2. Any occasion front door decoration, other than Christmas, (see section 30)
3. An article with fabric painting
4. A handmade stuffed toy
5. A sewn or knitted or crocheted teddy bear
6. A hand stuffed fur teddy bear
7. A handmade doll
8. A handmade novelty item for the garden
9. A handmade pincushion
10. A handmade puppet
11. Jewellery: An article made with glass beads
12. Jewellery: An article made with other than glass beads (name the mineral)
13. Jewellery: Pendent
14. Jewellery: 2 piece set
15. Jewellery: 3 piece set
16. Jewellery: an item for a special occasion
17. Jewellery: any other kind not listed above
18. An article made with quilling technique
19. A 3-D assembled puzzle or model, the base measuring no larger than 12" x 24" for display purposes

20. A four seasons wall hanging, minimum size, 15" by 15" or 38 cm by 38 cm

21. Article of **cross-stitch** - to measure under 10 inches (25 by 25 cm), - not framed
22. **Crossed-stitched** picture - framed, over 10 inches (25.4cm), but no larger than 15 inches (38.1cm). (Frame included in the measurement.)

24. An article displaying **tatting**
25. An article displaying **machine embroidery**
26. An article displaying **crewel** work
27. An article displaying **needlepoint**
28. A **crocheted** table cloth, larger than 12 inches, (30 cm), maximum size 50 inches, (90 cm)
29. An article of **crocheting**, mounted, under 12 inches (30.5cm)
30. An article of **sewing/needlework** made by "**Grandma and Me**" – **Child's name on tag.**
31. An article of needlework NOT listed above
32. Three articles for a bazaar
33. An item displaying one or more techniques, eg. embroidery and beading

34. A wall hanging or Advent calendar
35. Front door decoration – snowman, New Year, Winter, etc.
36. Table runner or topper
37. A decorated Christmas bag
38. Christmas stocking displaying needlework

41. An item displaying any **technique not listed** in a previous category (feather, wool, etc.)
42. A Christmas centerpiece, any medium, (accept real flowers), height 8 inches, (20 cm), symmetrical view
