Smartie Cookie Recipe

1/2 cup white sugar	1 ½ cup smarties
1 cup shortening	1 tsp baking soda
2 eggs	1 tsp salt
2 1/2 cups flour	1 ½ tsp vanilla
1 cup brown sugar	

Cream shortening, sugars and eggs. Mix well, add vanilla. Mix dry ingredients and add to creamed mixture. Add 1 cup smarties and use the rest to decorate. Drop by spoonfuls onto ungreased cookie sheet and bake at 375 degrees F for 12- 15 minutes.
