**INSTRUCTIONS: PLEASE READ HOMECRAFT AND QUILTING  
RULES CAREFULLY**

All entries in Class 38 must be in the Exhibit Hall by 11:00 am Friday of the Fair and may not be removed until 4:45 pm Monday of the Fair.

No person shall be permitted to enter more than one article per section in each class.

Each entry must be the work of the exhibitor, must be clean, and may be shown only two years. Preference will be given to new work. Soiled and damaged articles will not be accepted.

Should there be more than six (6) entries in any section, on the advice of the judge, a 4<sup>th</sup> prize will be given. At the discretion of the judge, with the approval of the Committee Head, a given class may be subdivided to make judging and competition as appropriate as possible. Entry tags must be fastened securely with safety pins. Exhibitors are required to present their current exhibitor ticket and number, with a list of entries, to a director before removing entries.

**ALL ENTRIES IN CLASS 38 MUST HAVE FABRIC SAMPLES  
ATTACHED AND MUST MEET THE SIZE REQUIREMENTS AS  
STIPULATED FOR EACH SECTION. FAILURE TO HAVE FABRIC  
SAMPLES ATTACHED AND FAILURE TO MEET THE SIZE  
REQUIREMENTS WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION.**

## O.A.A.S. ANNUAL CHAMPIONSHIP QUILTS COMPETITION

A COMPLETE SET OF ELIGIBILITY, RULES AND REGULATIONS IS AVAILABLE

The two championship quilts (hand quilted and machine quilted) are eligible to compete at the O.A.A.S. District meeting in November 2011. The winners at District proceed to competition at the O.A.A.S. Convention in Toronto in February 2012. If an exhibitor does not wish his or her quilt to compete, please state on the back of the entry tag. Upon making an entry into the O.A.A.S. Quilt Competition, the exhibitor agrees to participate in any promotional activities related to the competition.

## HAND QUILTED CHAMPIONSHIP: RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Entries must be solely made and hand quilted by the exhibitor.
- Entry quilts must be a minimum of 324" (810cm) measured on the perimeter
- The Grand Prize winner of the Hand Quilted Championship Quilt will receive \$500.00 at the Convention in February

### Hand Quilted Sections

1. Quilt - pieced, hand quilted, made solely by exhibitor.

Special Award for Section 1: Perpetual Trophy to first place in

2. Quilt – appliquéd, hand quilted, made solely by exhibitor.

Group Rules: A quilt in which the top has been designed or executed by a co-operative effort of three (3) or more persons. Please attach signatures of all those who worked on the quilt on the back of the entry tag. The exhibitor's name will be displayed.

## MACHINE QUILTED CHAMPIONSHIP: RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Entries must be solely made and machine quilted (not using a long arm machine) by the exhibitor.
- Entries must be a minimum perimeter of 192" (480 cm). Article may be square or rectangular, etc.
- Article must have visible machine quilting.
- The Grand Prize winner of the Champion Machine Quilt will receive an award along with a certificate and ribbon.

### Machine Quilted Section

1. Quilt – pieced or appliquéd, machine quilted, made solely by exhibitor.

**PLEASE INCLUDE FABRIC SAMPLES WITH ALL QUILTS, WALL HANGINGS AND OTHER ITEMS AND MAKE SURE THAT THE ENTRY MEETS THE SIZE REQUIREMENTS**

**THE FOLLOWING SECTIONS REQUIRE THAT THE QUILTS BE MADE SOLELY BY THE EXHIBITOR. PLEASE NOTE THAT SECTIONS 28S A) AND 28S B) ARE AVAILABLE FOR QUILTS PROFESSIONALLY QUILTED BY A LONG ARM QUILTER.**

2. Quilt – My first quilt by a beginner quilter, perimeter of 248" (620 cm) or larger

7. Quilt – any kind done solely by exhibitor that is not eligible for Sections 1 to 9 Please write on the back of the entry tag the uniqueness of this quilt which makes it ineligible for the previous Sections; i.e. size

10. Quilted clothing.
11. Lap Quilt – hand quilted, perimeter of more than 200" (500 cm), less than 300" (750 cm).
12. Lap Quilt – machine quilted, perimeter of more than 200" (500 cm), less than 300" (750 cm).
13. Bed Quilt – hand quilted, minimum perimeter of 300" (750cm)
14. Bed Quilt – machine quilted, minimum perimeter of 300" (750cm)
15. Quilted Runner or Table Topper
16. Quilted Bag
17. Any other quilted or tied item, i.e. place mats, candle mats, pillow shams, etc.

24. Wall Quilt – Contemporary or own design, not to exceed 200" (500 cm). Must be designed and made by exhibitor. Will be judged on innovative design, unusual use of materials and stitches, piecing, embellishments, as well as quilting and finishing. **MUST HAVE SLEEVE.**
