INSTRUCTIONS: This section is open to anyone with a physical or developmental disability. All projects may be completed using hand over hand if needed. There is no age limit for this section; all crafts can be completed by any age person. Please include age on the back side of the tag. For further rules and information, please read the instructions for class 45 Junior Crafts.

1. Barn Collage – find pictures in magazine or newspapers of animals, machinery or anything else you may find IN a barn. Glue to construction paper.
2. Paper Bag Scare Crow – protect your crops with a paper bag scare crow - created using any medium.
3. Tissue Paper Art – make a colourful picture using tissue paper. Mounted on construction paper.
4. Cotton Ball Sheep – use a toilet paper tube and cover it with cotton balls to create a unique sheep friend.
5. Friendship Bracelet – make a one of a kind friendship bracelet using beads and other medium.
6. Pine Cone Bird Feeder – using any medium make a bird feeder using a pine cone as the base.
7. Marble or Ping Pong Ball Painting – use either object or both to create an abstract picture with paper and paint. Hint: use a box with the paper taped inside!
8. Picture Frame – “Waste Not” picture frame that will hold a 5x7 picture using recycled or un-used objects.
9. Sponge Painting – use different shapes of sponge and different colours of paint to create a unique art piece.
10. Holiday Decoration – make a beautiful decoration to display during your favourite Holiday (Christmas, Easter, Halloween...), using any medium.

11. Homemade Puzzle - Colour a picture from a book or off of the Internet that has to do with Barns or a Farm. Then cut into a puzzle and mount onto heavy paper.
12. Salt dough friends – using a salt dough recipe create some friends, paint and decorate them and place on a paper plate. Paper plate may also be decorated.
13. Leaves and Seasons of Change – using any medium make a picture to show leaves of different shapes, colours and sizes.
