

AMBASSADOR OF THE FAIR COMPETITION

NEW IN 2011 Junior and Senior Categories

1. Contestants, male or female:
Senior: 17 years of age and over (must be 18 before mid-August 2012)
Junior: 13 to 17 years of age as of August 1, 2011
2. Must be a resident of The Town of Erin or neighbouring municipality.
3. Must have resided in Canada for the past two years.
4. Winner of the Senior Competition will represent the Erin Agricultural Society at the August 2012 Canadian National Exhibition (CNE) Ambassador of the Fair Contest.
5. Contestants will be judged on interview and speech, community knowledge and involvement, presentation, deportment, and personality.
6. Components of the competition include:
 - a. An interview of approximately 10 minutes in length for both Junior and Senior competitors
 - b. A speech about agriculture, agricultural societies, or some aspect of the Erin Fall Fair
Senior: approximately three to five minutes
Junior: approximately two to four minutes
 - c. A current events quiz consisting of 10 questions for Senior competitors
 - d. An impromptu question, which will be provided by the Committee.

8. Winner of the Senior Competition to receive \$1500 scholarship and 1st Runner-up to receive \$750 scholarship
Winner of the Junior Competition to receive \$350 scholarship and 1st Runner-up to receive \$150 scholarship
